

Primary 6 Intended Learning Plan

What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

In Literacy this term we will be focusing on improving our VCOP writing skills and carrying out weekly punctuation and grammar activities. These skills will help to enhance our understanding of different writing genres and develop the content of our personal and descriptive writing.

P6 will read every week with their reading group and will also be using a range of age-appropriate texts to further develop their comprehension and discussion skills.

Spelling will continue to be a weekly focus.



Mathematics

Primary 6 will focus on improving their mental arithmetic skills through daily activities and interactive games. We will also be focusing on place value to 1 million and place value to 2 decimals places.

Additionally, we will also be revisiting Time and patterns and relationships.

Later this term, we will learn to answer real life word problems in the Daily Rigour, developing our ability to decode problems expressed in word form and looking closely at problem solving strategies and methods.



Social Studies

Our first Social Studies topic of the year is Scotland's landscape and mapping. The class have highlighted the areas they would like to learn about including learning about continent names, country names, capital cities, rivers and railways on maps of Scotland, the UK, Europe and areas further afield.

In addition to this, we will be learning about children's rights in Scotland and making comparisons to those in other countries.



STEM

Primary 6 are incredibly lucky to have 1:1 iPad's!

We will continue to develop and improve our skills on TEAMS.

The class will be issued with iPad contracts which highlight the importance of internet safety, copy right, appropriate use of apps and software and using the iPad respectfully and responsibly. Both Primary 6 pupils and parents need to read and sign these contracts.

In Science, P6 will be learning about **Our different body systems**, including digestion, circulation, and respiration and how to make healthy lifestyle choices.



Expressive Arts

In art we will be creating self portraits and pop art names.

The class will also be researching
European artists e.g Vincent Van Gogh or
Pablo Picasso.

Primary 6 will continue to have their music lessons on a Tuesday with Mrs Ewen. This term, they will be learning to play melodic patterns and chords to accompany different songs on the ukulele.



Health & Well-Being

We will be continuing with the Building Resilience programme. This terms focus is 'Look on the Bright Side'.

Additionally, P6 will be working on improving their Independence, Self-Organisation, Time keeping and Effective Listening skills.

Primary 6 will also continue to have PE with Mr Devine on a Wednesday and Friday. The focus this term will be on throwing and catching tactics for different sports games
