

Primary 7 Intended Learning Plan

What will we be learning this term?

Language - Reading, Writing, Listening and Talking

In Literacy this term we will be focusing on improving our VCOP skills and using different spelling strategies. This will be a weekly focus

P7 will read every day with their reading group and will also be using Blooms reading cards to further develop their comprehension and discussion skills.

These skills will help to enhance our understanding of different writing genres and develop the content of our personal and descriptive writing.



Mathematics

This term we will be focusing on place value and mental arithmetic skills.

During these lessons we will be discussing how we can implement different strategies to answer questions and show each other how we have achieved this.

We will also focus on solving real life maths problems in the Daily Rigour. The resource focuses on mathematical word problems about current news stories.

In topic maths we will be learning about time including analogue and digital time, measuring time, using timetables



Social Studies

In Social Studies we will be learning about the main features of a democracy and discuss the rights and responsibilities of citizens in Scotland.

We will also investigate the features of an election through the process of electing our Clan Chiefs to begin to develop an understanding of how democracy works.

We will investigate how the needs of a particular group within the local community can be supported, using the school clan system as an example.

Technologies

In Technologies this term we will be :-

Coding through Coding Apps on the I pads: We will learn how to: -

Write codes with the long-term aim of building their own apps.

Code using sequences and reorder codes to give the same results.

Understand what a loop is and how it makes instructions more efficient.

Science & French

In Science, we will be learning about how key events & individuals have helped to shape the world. We will: -

Report and comment on current scientific news items.

Develop an appreciation of the contributions that individuals make to the world of science.

In French we will be learning to respond to questions about him/herself using sentences, phrases and words we will also be learning to share personal information on familiar topics such as expressing likes or dislikes with increasing confidence and accuracy.



Health & Well-Being/RME

Primary 7 will have PE on a Wednesday and Thursday afternoon with Mr Devine. A basketball group will have sessions with Tom from West Edinburgh Warriors on a Monday afternoon,

We will also be focusing on how to improve our Growth Mindset through discussion and analysing different story books.

We will be revisiting the Building Resilience programme throughout the year; this terms topic is Look on the Bright Side.

We will be looking at personal safety and how to deal with risk.
